

## Regular Maintenance

Wipe with dry cloth to remove surface dust. Do not use water, polish, or leather cleansers.



## General Recommendations

Treat stains promptly. The longer a stain remains on the textile, the more difficult it will be to remove. A professional cleaning service is recommended.

Never rub a stain with force or pressure as it could cause the stain to penetrate more quickly.

Keep away from direct sunlight and heating vents as sunlight can cause the leather to lighten and heat can cause the leather to dry out.

Never use cleaning solvents, furniture polish, oil, varnish, abrasive cleaners, ammonia, or soap with a detergent base.
